

Player and Family Handbook

Welcome to Lakeshore Youth Baseball Association. This handbook covers what every family needs to know for the season: how teams are formed, what the commitment looks like at each level, how the fields work, and who to ask when something goes wrong.

In-house teams practice once a week and play twice. Travel teams practice twice a week from April and play a league schedule plus three to four weekend tournaments. Every player is expected at every practice and game unless a coach is told beforehand.

Playing time in the in-house league is equal by rule. At the travel level it is earned, and coaches say so at tryouts. Respect for umpires, opponents and parents applies to everyone at every level, and the board follows up on every report.
